



REGULATION

Rules are accepted and subscribed by the participants at the time of the booking confirmation

Reservations and payments:

When booking we request a confirmation deposit of 50% of the agreed fee. The balance is due 60 days before departure. For bookings made within 60 days prior the date of departure the full amount will be paid at time of booking. In case of non-payment of the balance in time, the reservation will be canceled.

CANCELLATION OF WEEKS "INTRODUCTION TO SAILING" BY MURE A DRITTA

The organizer can cancel the program in case the minimum number of participants it has not been reached, or reasons beyond our control.

CANCELLATION OF WEEKENDS BY MURE A DRITTA

In case of reasons beyond our control or lack of minimum number, the amount paid is not lost, but remains valid for a later date or to any other activity within 1 year from the payment of the deposit.

CANCELLATION OF WEEKS BY THE CLIENT

In the event of a recession you will be charged a penalty in the following percentages:
50% for withdrawal up to 60 days from the departure date
No refund after that time.

CANCELLATION OF WEEKENDS / DAILY CRUISES BY CUSTOMER

total loss of the deposit/fee paid.

In case of bad weather for bookings of more days (weekends and weeks), cruises can not be deferred.

The boat and crew are available for the duration of the stay for the night, regardless of the weather.

For bookings of daily cruises, in case of storm or heavy rain, the Captain may decide to postpone the cruise to another date to be agreed with the client, based on the availability of the boat.

BAD WEATHER: very rough seas, storm or heavy rainfall such that it prohibits thecruise.





CHILDREN ON BOARD: children and minors are under the full responsibility of parents or carers. Should wear appropriate life jackets during navigation (not supplied) and comply with the rules given by the skipper. Failure to comply with the rules leads to the prompt return and no refund is provided. Children under 12 are accepted only for daily cruises, not for weekends or for weeks.

Luggage (for weekends or weeks): a soft bag with two / three T-shirts, two suits, a pair of shorts, a pair of long pants, a shirt, windproof jacket, boat shoes or sneakers with white soles. Trolley and bags with rigid parts will not be boarded.

Life on board: education and respect are the first rule to be respected. The common areas must be kept tidy and free from objects. On board skipper and co-skipper are always available to meet the needs of the participants, but not to act as valets of the guests.

Kitchen availability: Guests are not allowed to use the kitchen and the stove unless in the presence of the owners
